Participants will learn a bit about Judaism while making and shaping challah dough.

Susan, a Bedford resident, is the rabbi at Temple Shalom Emeth in Burlington and the author of <u>Challah</u>, <u>A Chewish Guide to the Torah</u> plus the children's books featuring Rabbi Rocketpower, the world's first-ever female rabbi superhero. She is committed to teaching others how easy it is to make challah and how it can be a fun and spiritual practice for everyone. Her assistants will be other members of the Bedford Clergy Association and Bedford's Police Chief, Robert Bongiorno.

This approximately two hour long activity is all ages friendly (yes, bring your children!) and every household will take home a loaf to bake. Ingredients will be supplied, but donations will be welcomed to benefit the Bedford Food Pantry.

Rabbi Abramson's books will be available to buy and a portion of the sales will also go to the Food Pantry. Please plan to bring a large bowl, a large spoon, and a dish towel. All other equipment will be supplied.
