The Bedford Arts and Crafts Society is sponsoring a workshop: *Elegant and Easy Fused Glass Pendants* led by Mary Johannessen on Tuesday, March 15, 1:30pm in the Flint Room of the Bedford Town Center Building on Mudge Way.

A \$15/person fee will cover materials and the firing to make two gorgeous fused glass pendants. Please email info@bacsma.org if you plan to attend to give us an estimate of how many will come. Bring your friends; the program is open to the public.

Create two mini-collage pendants in glass, one triangle and one rectangle, using precut glass. Experiment with opaque and transparent glasses. An assortment of pre-made decorative glass bits will be available for you to personalize your pieces. Satin cord, metal bails and adhesive will be included for each piece.

The only thing needed for class is curiosity. Mary will provide all precut materials. There will be glass scorers and breakers on hand if anyone wants to try their hand at creating custom shapes, but glass cutting skill is not necessary to participate in the workshop.

Mary will bring the pendants to her studio for firing and they will be ready the following afternoon. A member of the Arts and Crafts Society will pick up and distribute the finished pieces.
