Genograms are a way of pictorially displaying your family relationships that go beyond what we usually think of as a family tree. After several years of creating art, Sandra has found a way to use genograms in her work. She uses the genogram symbols to help depict family relationships in prints and collages. In her work, she shows the way families interact using patterns and materials found in nature. In one series she uses trees whose slender trunks are composed of small, colorful symbolic pictures representing family members lives and how they tie together.

Sandra lives in Lexington, many of her works have been accepted in locally-juried shows.
