First Parish on Bedford Common will host a concert and performance by the famed Lakatos Family Hungarian Gypsy Band on Tuesday, May 24 at 7 pm

Gyorgy Lakatos was born in Budapest, Hungary, now lives in Florida, and is a world renowned musician playing the guitar, and cimbalom. He is a songwriter, performer, and a "Gypsy Heart." It is said that "his agile hands caress the strings of his guitar in a manner never before seen. He redefines music with his supernatural talent." He has played the cimbalom since he was a very young child.

All his family are musicians, known world-wide,

and he carries a tradition passed down through generations. When asked about his music, he says, "It's the air I breathe. Without it, I can't exist."

Gyorgy Lakatos won the Mr. Goldenhand Award in 2016. Gergely Nogradi, known as the Hungarian Pavarotti, was named Europe's Best Voice in 2015. Gyorgy Lakatos, Jr. is a violin virtuoso.

First Parish Senior Minister, Rev. John Gibbons, says, "We have hosted these extraordinary shows before. They are from another era and another world, an extravaganza of gypsy folk and classical operetta, with costumed singers, dancers, and dazzling musicianship." The show is an extension of First Parish's partnership with a remote village in Transylvania.
