

The Great Road - Status

- Master Plan completed in August 2012
- BOS meeting March 2016 last update
- Preliminary design for The Great Road is ongoing
- Willson Park design is now separate from overall corridor
 - Roadside Walk Shop (Safety Audit) to be conducted in April 2017
 - Additional concept refinement to be developed
- Two project phases are constructed or will be under construction
- Recommended plan will vary slightly
 - 5 foot bike lanes
 - Crossing treatments at Hillside and Bacon will be reconsidered

The Great Road - Phasing

- Phase 1: The Great Road at South Road/Springs Road, and the Fire Station signals – Construction complete
- Phase 2: The Great Road at Mudge Way (SRTS) Construction underway
- Phase 3: North Road from Willson Park to Carlisle Road and remainder of The Great Road to Hillside Ave /Bacon Road intersection
- Phase 4: Willson Park area



Overhead utilities will not be relocated underground.

Design Goals

- Design historic streetscape to fit The Great Road
- Update materials and locations of walkways and crosswalks
- Update lighting with period lights
- Minimize length of crosswalks and narrow roadway width
- Accommodate bicycles along the length of the corridor
- Reduce curb cuts and modify roadway geometry to decrease vehicle conflicts
- Add or update traffic signals as appropriate
- Enhance gateways into Historic District

North Road

- Mid-block pedestrian crossing
- Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacon (RRFB)
- New ADA compliant sidewalks
- Opportunities for tree plantings, fencing/walls and other landscape amenities
- Coordinate with Willson Park






Willson Park area

Mudge Way area

- Intersection advertised for construction Fall/Winter 2016 "Safe Routes to School" program
- New traffic signal, roadway/sidewalk improvements, bike lanes & new pedestrian crossing at First Church of Christ
- Contractor has mobilized
- The Great Road corridor project will "tie-into" the Mudge Way improvements



The Great Road – First Church to Fletcher Road

- Roadway cross section consolidation
 - Parking lane on the north side
 - Landscape buffer on south side
- Bike lanes
- New ADA compliant sidewalks with more green space
- Landscape, lighting, streetscape amenities


