



Town of Bedford Recycling Guide



Automated Recycling Collection Starts July 1

- Each household will receive a blue, 65-gallon recycling cart the week of June 24.
- There is no need to sort recyclables.
- Each cart has a serial number assigned to the address. Recycling carts, like Trash carts, are property of the Town of Bedford.
- The DPW and Republic Services will collect the gray recycling bins once the new program is running.

Starting July 1, Republic Services will be collecting recycling with an automated collection truck and will not collect any material in other containers.

Residents should put their recycling in the new recycling cart by 7 a.m. The trash and recycling carts should be 3 feet apart and away from any other obstacles.

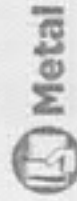

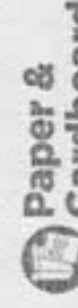
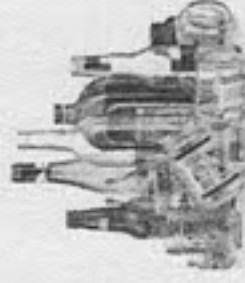
Metal
