

SHAWSHEEN TECH ~ CLASS OF 2021 BY THE NUMBERS

- 313 members of the class: 66% will go on to two and four-year colleges and universities, 30% to careers and 4% will join the military
- 154 scholarships to 76 different recipients were awarded totaling \$144,300 in awards
- 23 members of the class are members of the National Honor Society and the National Vocational Technical Honor Society
- 85 students received the John and Abigail Adams Scholarship because of their high-ranking performances on the MCAS
- With 313 seniors, 60% of the class worked at co-op jobs in their fields of study this year
- 45 seniors earned college credits for successfully completing college-level courses in English Composition, Statistics, and American Government, while seniors at Shawsheen, in partnership with Middlesex Community College
- 7 seniors from Design & Visual Communications earned 3 college credits through a dual-enrollment program with Montserrat College of Art
- Students earned dozens of industry certifications including Adobe Certified Associate, Microsoft Excel, Word and PowerPoint, CompTIA A+ Certification, OSHA, EPA 608, 609, & R-410A, The American Heart Association Heartsaver, MACWIC Advanced Manufacturing, Automotive Service Excellence (ASE), I-Car Certification, Certified Solidworks Associate, First Aid and Basic Life Support Certification, Hot Work Certification, and ServSafe
- Multiple students have their acceptance into Union Apprenticeship programs, including 2 at the Local IBEW 103 (Electricians), 1 into the Carpenters Union and multiple students awaiting word with the Plumbers & Gasfitters - Local 12, and at the Bricklayers and Allied Craftsmen - Local 3
- 13 Cosmetology students are state licensed Cosmetologists after earning 1,000 salon hours and passing the Massachusetts State Board of Cosmetology Exam

- 25 Health Assisting students are eligible to become Certified Nursing Assistants, with 17 students already completing all testing requirements.
- 14 Dental Assisting students are eligible to become registered as Dental Assistants through the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, with students completing the requirements from the Dental Assisting National Board to become certified in Infection Control, Radiation Health and Safety National Exam, & Radiology
- 17 Medical Assisting students are prepared and eligible to receive their certification as an American Medical Technologists
- 146 students attended the SkillsUSA district competition, with 65 earning medals! 38 members of the Class of 2021 won medals, including 20 Gold, 12 Silver and 6 Bronze
- Culinary Arts students adapted their profession and provided curbside pickup for community members when the Ram's Head Restaurant was unable to remain open
- The Robotics Teams, the RoboRams, and the RoboRebels, competed in two events this year, virtually from the Engineering shop. The RoboRams and RoboRebels finished 10th and 11th respectfully overall in their first competition, advancing to the Southern New England Championships. The RoboRams finished 8th overall just missing out on the VEX Worlds competition, while the RoboRebels finished 27th
- Shawsheen's Varsity Esports team competed in their fifth season of competitive play, adding a league title and 5 teams to the regional league
